

SaddleBrooke Genealogy Club Board Meeting
March 1, 2018

The Club officers held a brief board meeting after the luncheon on March 1, 2018.

Treasurer Pat Rourke, provided a report on the club finances. She mentioned our effort to spend down our money over the past few years. This effort has not been especially successful. Ms Rourke suggested that we branch out and get a speaker who is not local. We can afford to pay for travel expenses for such a speaker.

Ms. Rourke had brought up the fee for the website at the last meeting which is coming due and questioned who might receive the bill for the website fee. This month she said she believes the fee is included in the monthly bill.

She also said that Gloria Quigg wants to teach two genealogy classes this year. She taught two classes in 2017. The board has no objection to Ms. Quigg teaching two classes this year and is ready to fund handouts and other expenses for these classes.

Vice President Patty Burke said she will not be at the April and May meetings. She has arranged for Holly Gibson to give a talk on sources in April. Carol Tibor and Christine Nelson will meet Ms. Gibson at the HOA 1 clubhouse at 11:30 am and have lunch with her.

Last month the board had discussed SaddleBrooke Ranch's new policy barring SaddleBrooke residents from participating in SaddleBrook Ranch's clubs. The board does not want to prohibit SaddleBrooke Ranch residents from continuing to participate in the SB Genealogy Club. HOA 1 suggests that clubs revise their bylaws to document their position on participation by SaddleBrooke Ranch residents.

The board discussed coordination of a possible trip to Salt Lake City by club members for in-depth genealogical research. A committee should be formed to research the details of such a trip and determine when the trip will take place. Participants should be able to choose whether to drive or fly, how long to stay and whether to share a room or get a private room. The committee would identify hotels in the area and find out prices.

The Writing SIG was mentioned. It meets the 3rd Monday of the month at Rondi Yancey's home.
