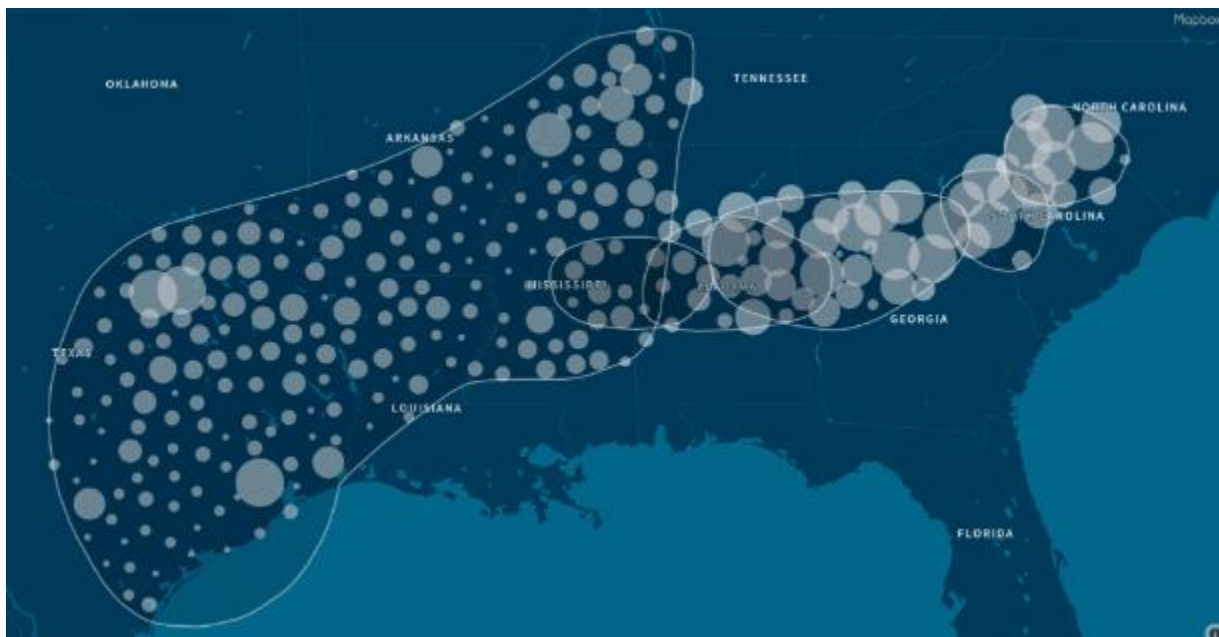
### AncestryDNA Test on Sale for \$79

**Now that [Family Tree DNA](#) is accepting free transfers into their [Family Finder](#) test, the logical place for new people to get started with genetic genealogy is the [AncestryDNA](#) test. With more than three million users in the database, most new testers will discover more genetic relatives than you could imagine.**

**Then you will be able to transfer your raw data for free into Family Finder, [MyHeritage](#), and [GEDmatch.com](#). That's really maximizing your results from just a \$79 investment. This sale ends 4/26.**

**[AncestryDNA](#) also includes an ethnic ancestry report. But the most exciting new feature is Genetic Communities. This combines DNA results with geographic information from hundreds of thousands of family trees. It's a clever way to place us in more recent subgroups than what the ethnic ancestry reports reveal. It will only get better over time.**

**My first Genetic Community is Early Settlers of the Deep South, which perfectly matches the history of my paternal line. See the image below:**



## **A Great Family Tree DNA Sale**

With all the focus on autosomal DNA tests lately, it's easy to forget about Y-DNA testing and mitochondrial DNA testing of the direct paternal and maternal lines respectively. [Family Tree DNA](#) is the unquestioned leader in both tests.

For Y-DNA testing (men only) the current sweet spot is the 67-marker [Y-DNA test](#). It's on sale for just \$209. That's a \$59 savings. Other options are the minimum test of 37 markers (now \$129), and the ultimate 111-marker test (now \$289).

The [Full Mitochondrial Sequence test](#) is on sale for \$149). That's a \$50 savings. This tests 100% of your mitochondria and is the only mtDNA test you will ever need.

[Family Finder](#) is also on sale for just \$59. You might wonder why you would buy this test directly if you can transfer AncestryDNA or 23andMe results for free (or just \$19 to access all the tools).

There are two advantages to testing directly on Family Finder: 1. The DNA of the tested person will be saved for future tests. That's especially important with older relatives. 2. You will also get "speculative" matches with many distance cousins. The latest versions of AncestryDNA and 23andMe have different data sets and there isn't enough common data in a transfer to confidently display speculative matches.

The [Family Tree DNA sale](#) ends 4/27.

## **Living DNA Also on Sale**

[Living DNA](#) is an expanded ethnic ancestry test, especially suited for people with some British ancestry. It breaks down your DNA mix across 80 world regions, including 21 in Britain and Ireland. It does not currently provide a list of genetic relatives, but that is an anticipated addition.

This test is based on the well respected [People of the British Isles](#) project. A follow-up study of Irish ancestry is expected to add a further breakdown of sub regions within Ireland in a couple of months. Plus, a new study of German ancestry has recently been announced.

I received my results recently and was impressed. By all indications, [Living DNA](#) is going to be the ultimate DNA test for breaking down European ancestry into sub regions. The test is currently on sale for \$119 (a savings of \$40).

## **No Word Yet on 23andMe**

At the time I am writing this, [23andMe](#) has not yet announced a sale for DNA Day. If you're interested in doing this test, just keep checking my link for the next few days.
