Are you new to Family Tree Maker? From the Beginning – learning to use the basics of one of the major software programs to research and maintain your family information

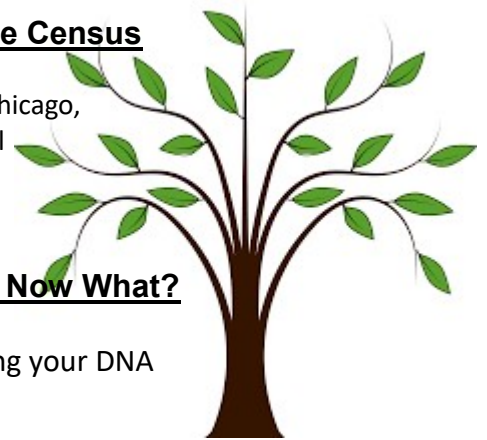
### **Jeri Taylor - Family Tree Maker INTERMEDIATE (Afternoon Session)**
