Betty Lou Malesky, a Certified Genealogist, will present a program at the November 4th SaddleBrooke Genealogy Club meeting to assist in overcoming brick walls encountered in tracing women in family trees. Often, through marriages,

maiden names do not appear in ancestry records.

Betty Lou will share information on how to track down "Women Without Shadows: Gone Without a Trace."

She is a resident of Green Valley and is a frequent lecturer, writer, and researcher. As Malesky says, "Most genealogical problems can be solved by review and analysis. Often the very clue needed is buried in the information we already have."

She is a member of a number of genealogical/historical societies. She has written genealogy columns for publications. She is a descendant of Scots-Irishmen who served in the New Jersey Continental Line during the American Revolution.
