### **Google Earth Pro**

- 1. Download : <earth.google.com>
- 2. Chrome or “versions”
- 3. Run web/mobile/icon on desktop
- 4. Tip! Use the “tip box” and “help”

### **Tool Bar:**

- 1. Historical Maps

### **Sample search:**

- 1) Go to Earth. Make sure that 3-D buildings is selected in the layers toolbox
- 2) Insert Address
- 3) “Pegman” he’s in the upper left corner. To activate him, just click on him, then move to the area you want to look at. If street view is available, you will see blue lines. You can navigate with the up/down arrows, or the hand
- 4) Also on the left side is the larger/smaller tool. You can also use the wheel on your mouse
